EQ: Feeling safe

<p><u>Task 3</u></p>	<p>Help a member of the family to prepare a meal to share. Can you measure out the right ingredients?</p>
<p><u>Task 4</u> EQ task</p>	<p>Our EQ focus is FEELING SAFE. Feeling safe means you do not expect either harm or hurt, emotionally or physically. Think of the different activities that you may do, at home, in school and make a list of how you keep safe while doing them. Also think of different peoples jobs e.g. builder, farmer, police officer, fire fighter etc and list what they use to keep them safe.</p>
