<u>Task 1</u>	<p>Some dinosaurs were over 6 metres tall. Research the heights of 5 different types of dinosaur and put them in order of smallest to largest. Measure yourself and work out where you would go in the order.</p>
<u>Task 2</u>	<p>Choose a dinosaur find out information about them. Create a fact file. E.g. Where did they live? What did they look like? What did they eat?</p>
<u>Task 3</u>	<p>Create a list of foods that herbivore and carnivore dinosaurs might eat of they were alive today. Create a dinosaur menu being as creative as you can.</p>
<u>Task 4</u>	<p>Make a dinosaur fossil https://www.bbc.co.uk/cbeebies/makes/presenters-making-a-fossil</p> <p>You will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">200g salt150g flour150g coffee grounds100-120ml cold coffee or waterDinosaur toy <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Combine salt, flour, and water in a small bowl or dish. Mix well until a soft dough forms.• When the dough forms, pinch off small fistfuls to shape into flattened rounds, similar to the shape and size of a cookie.• Press your dinosaur toy into the dough.• Bake at 200 degrees until your fossils are dry.
